- ❖ **DATE:** Saturday, June 1st , 2024
- ❖ **TIME:** 9 am-6 pm
Note: PLEASE BE ON TIME FOR ALL ACTIVITIES. If you are late, you may be eliminated from the competition.
- ❖ **PLACE:** Oceanside Pier Amphitheater: 301 The Strand N, Oceanside, CA 92054
- ❖ **EVENT:** Poomsae (Form) & Kyorugi (Sparring) & Breaking
- ❖ **ELIGIBILITY:** Taekwondo Practitioners of all ages, sex, and rank, who have trained and understand Tae Kwon Do rule.
- ❖ **REGISTRATION & FEES:**
 - Entries post-marked on or before May 20th 2024:
 - \$105 for one event, Addition Event \$15
 - Entries post-marked on or after May 21th 2024:
 - \$115 for one event, Addition Event \$15

- ❖ **ADMISSION FEE:** Above age 5 - \$20 Under age 5 – Free.
- ❖ **MANDATORY EQUIPMENT:**
 - V-neck or conventional white DoBok. All Kyorugi competitors
 - Must wear (WTF approved) headgear, chest protector, forearm pad, shin-instep pad,
 - Groin cup(male) and Mouth piece.
- ❖ **AWARD:**
 - Poomsae: 1-Gold Medal, 1-Silver Medal, 2-Bronze Medal
 - Kyorugi: 1-Gold Medal, 1-Silver Medal, 2-Bronze Medal
 - Breaking: 1-Gold Medal, 1-Silver Medal, 2-Bronze Medal
- ❖ **COMPETITOR RULES**
 1. Poomse Division
 - a. Division will be based upon gender, age, and rank.
 - b. Each division will have no more than 4 competitors **EXCEPT Black Belts.**
 - c. Scores will be based on proper order, beauty, grace, rhythm, accuracy, power, technique and attitude.
 - d. Taegeuk 1-8, Palgae 1-8, and Black Belt Poomse(Koryo, Kumjang, Taebaek,etc...)
 2. Kyorugi Division
 - a. Division will be based upon gender, age, and rank.
 - b. Each division will have no more than 4 competitors **EXCEPT Black Belts.**
 - c. Modified WTF competition rules will be used.
 3. Breaking Division
 - a. Division will be based upon gender, age, and rank.
 - b. Any combination of Front kick, Side kick, Back kick, Spinning Kick (Jumping kicks will earn extra points)
 - c. 3 kicks max.

2024 Important Information

Poomsae: All divisions will perform ONE poomsae based on your rank. There will be no more than 4 competitors to a division.

Sparring: There will be no more than 4 competitors to a division. Except for Black Belts. 20-point gap rule will be applied.

Breaking: For fairness and consistency, **no outside boards will be allowed.** Boards will be available for purchase at the event.

Coach Pass: Receive a FREE Coach Pass for every 10 registered athletes.

Mandatory Equipment:

- Standard white, official, V-neck TKD uniform (Sparring) in good condition.
- Official USAT or WT chest protector with red and blue scoring zones.
- Official WT shin protector and forearm protectors.
- Groin protector (required for males); must be worn inside the uniform.
- Official USAT or WT head protector and gloves (gloves are the only mandatory for black belts).
- Official WT Taekwondo mouth guard. MUST BE CLEAR OR WHITE.
- Official WT Taekwondo instep pads.

We also would like to remind you that proper personal hygiene (i.e. clean and short nails; clean body and uniform) is part of competition rules and etiquette.

Weigh-ins: There will be no weigh-in for this tournament.

Awards: 1st, 2nd and two 3rd place winners in each division will be awarded. However, all competitors 11 years old and under will get medals.

IMPORTANT NOTE: **The tournament director may modify some rules according to the local conditions. They also reserve the right to combine or divide weight categories depending on the size of the group.**

Elite Class Division:

Competitors are required to perform only Poomsae (form) designed for their specific rank.

Scores are based on:

- Accuracy: Correct movement, correct placement or technique, balance
- Presentation: Strength, speed, rhythm, expression of energy

Authorized Poomsae are those approved by the World Federation: Taeguk 1 – 8 Jang and Black Belt Poomsae: Koryo, Keumgang, Taekbaek, etc.

Rules:

- Black Belts must demonstrate a form that corresponds with their rank.
- Spectators and parents will not be allowed on the competition floor during Poomsae competition
- NO shoes, jewelry, or accessories are allowed. Clean uniforms and belts are required.
- Synchronized forms may be performed with or without music.
- Gender and ranks maybe combined at the discretion of the tournament director.

Awards:

1st, 2nd, and two 3rd place winners in each division will be awarded medals.

Note: Tournament director may modify some rules according to the local condition.

Breaking

Each competitor is allowed to have up to three (3) techniques for breaking

- Competitors must have their own board holders.
- Competitors must buy boards at the tournament.
- Competitors can have up to 3 boards for each break.
- Each board you do not break will count against your score.
- Competitor will have 40 seconds from start to finish the break(s).
- Higher technique breaks will receive higher points.

Awards:

1st, 2nd and two 3rd place winners in each division will be awarded medals.

Note: Tournament director may modify some rules according to the local condition.

2024 U.S Elite Taekwondo Championship Competition Rules

**2024 U.S Elite Cup Taekwondo Championship uses competitor's birth date to determine the age of all competitors.

KYORUGI (SPARRING):

The current and modified USAT & WT competition rules will govern this championship depending on age and rank.

NO HEAD CONTACT

There is absolutely no head contact for competitors Age 7 & Under (Black Belts) and 11 & Under (Color Belt divisions)

JUNIOR SAFETY RULES (JSR)

Junior Safety Rules will be applied to 8 – 11 YEAR OLD BLACK BELTS, 12 – 17 YEAR OLD BLACK BELTS & ALL COLOR BELT, and 33 & OVER BLACK BELT DIVISIONS. A head contact producing a minor injury (bruising, abrasion, or bleeding) will result in a one-point deduction for the attacker.

Excessive head contact resulting in the inability to continue will disqualify the attacker at the discretion of the referee.
